

# Call for Project Team Members!

**Project:** Developing a competency assessment tool to be initially piloted this FY. The project team will (a) design the general layout and workflow of the tool, which the web team will develop, and (b) guide the tool's deployment. The phase 1 tool will include user profiles, position-specific and aspirational competency selection, and individual assessment. The long-term vision is to expand its functions (e.g., development plans and dashboards) and offer it to all Federal agencies.

**What's Included:** We invite people who have experience or would like to gain more experience in any of the following aspects:

- Competency assessment
- Database management
- Rapid prototyping
- User/usability testing
- Presenting and facilitation
- Qualitative data synthesis
- OPM website development
- Guidance material creation
- Deployment and oversight
- Data analysis and reporting

**Timeline:** The project team will work for 8 weeks to design the tool. As the web team develops the tool, the project team may have limited activities (e.g., questions, testing, approvals). When the tool is complete, the project team will develop guidance and oversee the tool's deployment.

Apr 2–20 (3 weeks)	<b>Design:</b> Meet 3 hrs/wk (two 1.5-hr meetings); at-desk work depending on interest
Apr 23–30 (1 week)	<b>Test:</b> Host workshop at pilot org retreat to test prototype and collect feedback
May 1–11 (2 weeks)	<b>Refine:</b> Meet 3 hrs/wk (two 1.5-hr meetings); at-desk work depending on interest
May 14–25 (2 weeks)	<b>Deliver:</b> Discuss final design requirements with web team and modify as needed
